On Wednesday May 1st, the United Methodist General Conference removed wording from the Book of Discipline that forbid same sex marriage and the ordination of LGBTQ ministerial candidates. Local pastors may now perform same-sex marriages and local churches may host these events.

Members of the LGBTQ community of the United Methodist Church are eligible for ordination and higher offices within the denomination.
